Responsibilities

- To assist in developing a one-week training workshop to be held in Toronto.
- To provide training in screenwriting for television series, including different genres and formats.
- To help program participants develop their material during the workshop.
- To introduce and moderate discussion with guest speakers, including screenwriters, producers, television executives and agents.
- To introduce participants to the business aspects of a career in screenwriting.
- To review the participants' final materials and help select the intern for a Bell Media TV series.

Qualifications

- Minimum seven years' experience writing Canadian fiction television series, produced in a variety of genres.
- Minimum five years' experience, with appropriate credit as a senior story editor or showrunner, to demonstrate knowledge of how the writing room works and the screenwriter's role in the process.
- Proven workshop and teaching experience.
- Must be a WGC member in good standing.

Schedule

- October 2015: 2 days of prep time.
- January 18 to 22, 2016: 5 days to lead all sessions of the workshop.
- May 2016: 3 weeks on the internship jury to review participants' final projects and help select the internship winner.
