#### **Responsibilities**

To help the screenwriter fully develop his or her creative material including pitch, bible, character profiles, story lines and sample script.

To help the screenwriter develop a work schedule for completing his or her project.

To share expertise, knowledge, professional development advice and opportunities as needed.

#### **Qualifications**

A minimum of five years experience as a screenwriter for or story editor on produced fiction Canadian television series.

Previous mentorship or teaching experience.

Excellent communication skills and a sense of diplomacy.

A flexible schedule to accommodate a one-hour-a-week meeting with the screenwriter by email, telephone or Skype.
